Onix Paddle Differences

ONIX ensures that each of the main components of the paddle is of the highest quality and precision:

- Face/Skin (Graphite/control off the paddle or Composite/power off the paddle)
- Core (Nomex/Paper, Aluminum/Metal, or Polypropylene/Plastic)
- Shape (affects the balance and sweet spot)
- Weight of the paddle • **Light:** < 7.4 oz. • **Medium:** 7.4 - 8.2 oz. • **Heavy:** 8.2+ oz.)

Composite / Graphite Stryker

- Nomex core – good touch
- Oversize shape – a little more refined sweet spot.
- Light weight paddle.
- Great lower-price composite paddle.



Composite / Graphite Evoke Tear Drop

- Polypropylene core – good touch and quieter
- Tear Drop shape – gives the paddle a balance and sweet spot similar to a tennis or racquetball racquet. Sweet spot near closer to the top of the paddle.
- Light weight paddle.
- Good option for people converting to Pickleball from other racquet sports.



Composite/Graphite Phantom

- Aluminum core – Power and speed.
- Wide Body shape – gives a wider, more generous sweet spot.
- Medium (Graphite) / Heavy (Composite) weight paddle.
- An elite, powerful paddle that is used by professionals and beginners alike.



Graphite/Composite Z5

- Nomex core – good touch
- Wide Body shape – gives a wider, more generous sweet spot
- Medium (Graphite) / Heavy (Composite) weight paddle
- Our best-selling paddle for both professionals and beginners.



Graphite Inferno

- Aluminum Core – most power in the game.
- Wide Body shape – gives a wider, more generous sweet spot
- Medium weight paddle.
- Edgeless paddle – gives you even more surface area.



Composite / Graphite Slammer

- Nomex core – good touch
- Standard shape – a longer handle length, shorter paddle size.
- Light weight paddle.



Composite/Graphite Evoke XL

- Polypropylene core – good touch and quieter
- Oversize shape – a little more refined sweet spot with good balance.
- Light weight paddle.
- A great touch-paddle that is also very quiet.



Graphite Zen

- Aluminum core – good touch and quieter
- Oversize shape – a little more refined sweet spot with good balance.
- Medium weight paddle.
- A power-paddle that is popular among professional players.



Graphite React

- Dual Core – Polypropylene core with a Nomex insert. Gives you the control of a polypropylene with the sweet spot and additional power of a Nomex.
- Wide Body shape – gives a wider, more generous sweet spot.
- Heavy weight paddle.
- A professional-level paddle that combines both touch and power.



Graphite Sub Zero

- Foam Core with Carbon Fiber ribs – Unlike most other paddles, this paddle has a different core. It's a foam core (which deadens the ball) with carbon fiber ribs, to give the paddle some strength and a larger sweet spot.
- Wide Body shape – gives a wider, more generous sweet spot.
- Medium weight paddle.
- Our top-of-the-line paddle which is unlike any other paddle on the market.
